- Strategies covered include brainstorming, essay planning, establishing a writing focus, evaluating sources and developing critical thinking skills.



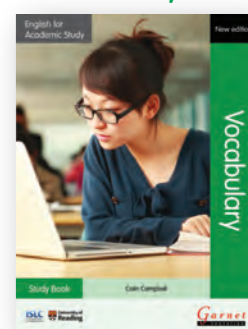
